A level Results day: Thursday 15th August 2019

Obtaining Results

Results will be available online from 7.00pm via the Parents Portal. Please ensure you and your son/daughter test access on receipt of this note. If you have forgotten your password please contact our Director of ICT, Mr Andy Hassard, by email: andy.hassard@ellesmere.com as soon as possible.

You may still telephone Reception from 8.00am on results day or call in personally should you prefer.

UCAS will begin emailing candidates with details of university decisions from early morning.

On the Day

- Candidates should:
 - Be available when the results come out. If problems arise Admissions Tutors expect to talk to applicants directly.
 - Have all UCAS documentation and correspondence available (including their UCAS number).
 - Make sure that UCAS are notified of any change of address. This is particularly important for those who originally gave the school as their correspondence address.
- If a candidate meets the conditions of an offer no immediate action is necessary. UCAS will confirm the place on Track.
- If results are not as expected or hoped for it is necessary to act quickly. The following notes give guidance on courses of action:
 - Save time by using the UCAS Track Service on its website. This features details of university decisions. (Candidates need their application number and password.)
 - Use the UCAS website to check the official list of course vacancies in Clearing- necessary if a candidate has not met their conditional offers. Clearing vacancies will be listed on www.ucas.com from early July.
 - If a place is not found through Clearing, a candidate could consider re-application through UCAS for entry in 2020.
 - Candidates are expected to know their commitments at confirmation. If they are placed at an institution they must take up the place or withdraw completely and re-apply.
 - Re-marks of A Level Papers only rarely result in the change to the final A Level grade.
 - **Priority re-marks** need to be requested as soon as possible after results day if universities are to be persuaded to hold a place for candidates narrowly missing their offers.
