## Ellesmere College Rugby tour of Canada 2019

Following my last letter, I can confirm that there has been a sufficient level of interest to run a Rugby Tour to Canada in October half term 2019. Touring is a fantastic experience and the memories last a lifetime. This tour is open to all boys in the current year 10, 11 and 12 age groups, regardless of team. I have attached an outline itinerary and cost.

At this moment, we are asking for a firm commitment to go with a non-returnable deposit of £250. Places are limited and if the tour is oversubscribed then a selection process will take place. Based on the places we have available, an initial costing is £2,100 per person, with the proviso that there are no significant changes in the near future, which may affect the pound. Please see the itinerary for details of what is included.

Payment for the tour will be made over an 8 month period, via standing order, starting in January, excluding the initial deposit which can be made by cheque or bank transfer. We would ask you to arrange to pay by standing order with your bank. Payments will begin as soon as possible to help spread the cost. Please could I ask you to look at the proposed schedule and return your deposit with the slip by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2018.
