GCSE DANCE

Dear Parent,

I am delighted to inform you that GCSE Dance will be available at Ellesmere College as of February 2023. This will be offered as an additional GCSE to students in year 9 upwards who show a keen interest in the subject. It will run off timetable in a weekly session each Thursday from 4.00pm to 6.00pm and as an extra activity there is a charge, as outlined below.

Dance is a powerful and expressive subject which encourages students to develop their creative, physical, emotional and intellectual capacity, whatever their previous experience in the subject. The students will be studying the AQA specification which is split into three sections: Performance, Choreography and Dance Appreciation. The specification recognises the role of dance in young people's lives and students will study a range of dance styles and style fusions. Apart from the solo performance, they can choose any style in which to perform and choreograph, providing it meets the assessment criteria. This will be carefully outlined by the teacher and guidance will be given throughout. The study of the anthology of six professional works will develop their ability to critically appraise professional dance works as well as their own work and will encourage the students to engage in practical tasks.

How GCSE Dance is assessed:

Students performance in set Solo & Duet/Trio: 30% of GCSE

Students own Choreography: 30% of GCSE Dance Appreciate (written exam): 40% of GCSE

Additional information about the course:

- GCSE Dance will take place with Miss Charlotte Evans on a Thursday 4.00pm 6.00pm.
- The cost of the programme is £100 per term.
- Buses will leave at normal times so alternative transport home needs to be arranged.
