## **EXPEDITIONS – Michaelmas 2018**

I am writing to inform you of this term's three day expedition destinations for Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October to Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2018. Your son/daughter will be informed in detail of their individual expedition, but this letter is to apprise you of the timings and general overview of those staff in charge.

Arts Award - Mrs M Hutchings: Pupils will attend one of three separate Arts Award expeditions:

Mrs Paul will be taking pupils on three separate day trips. This will involve a trip to Blackpool on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October to include a show; Stoke on Trent for Trentham Gardens and Monkey World for photography on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> October; College based Flamenco dancing on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October with Mrs Reynolds.

Mrs Hutchings, Mrs Phillips, and Mr Formstone to Haworth (staying at the YHA) to view the Yorkshire Sculpture Park, Bronte Museum and Styal Mill.

Mr Coupe, Mrs Fisher and Mrs Schubert to Liverpool and Manchester, staying at the Premier Inn in Hyde Park, visiting Manchester City Art Gallery 'The Whitworth' and on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October the Terracotta Warriors exhibition in Liverpool. Return to college on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October will be late (approximately 11:30pm) so pupils should arrange to be collected by parents

**Green Team - Mrs C Allen:** Green Team will be walking and visiting local points of interest in the Peak District, staying at llam Self Catering Bunkhouse (National Trust property).

**DofE Gold Canoe – Mr J Underhill:** Canoeists will undertake three days intensive canoe training on the River Severn at Frankwell, Shrewsbury and the lake at Whitemere. Boarders can stay overnight in College and Day Pupils will be back each day in time for 5:30pm buses. The canoeists will return to College by 5.00pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October. Mr Underhill will issue appropriate kit lists directly to pupils via their College emails.

**DofE Gold Walking – Mr M Clewlow:** Three days training in North Wales including navigation skills and camp craft. The group will be assisted by Mr I. Carter of Eden Adventures, who has worked with our CCF pupils many times. The group will return to college by 5.00pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October.

**DofE Silver – Miss R Hansford**: Pupils will visit an area in Snowdonia National Park and spend three days walking and map reading. They will camp out on Tuesday and Wednesday evening and return to college at 5.00pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October.

**DofE Bronze - Mrs C McClelland & Mrs J Evans:** Pupils will visit the Llandegla area on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October and Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> October to do their practice walk, camping out on the Tuesday night, and returning to college on Wednesday 5.00pm. Thursday will be a one day activity to be confirmed.

**CCF Navy and RAF - Mr C Collins**: Cadets will visit and stay at Southport Sailing Club, where they will work towards their Level 1/2 Sailing qualifications. They will leave College on the evening of Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> October and return on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October. All cadets will be provided with a full kit list well in advance.

**CCF Army - Mr M Clewlow:** Year 10 and 11 and Sixth Form Army cadets will go to Nesscliffe for the three days of expos to engage in military exercises on the training area. They will return to college at 5.00pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October.

Year 9 CCF will be in Llangollen/Quinta, Bronze DofE training.

## **Equipment suggestions:**

If your child is in Middle and Senior school and part of the Activity programme they will, at some stage, need to have:

Sturdy walking boots especially if they are doing DofE.

Tents will be provided as will cookers, but if your child would prefer to obtain their own cooker then please ask the activity leader to suggest the most suitable type. (Gas rather than methane).

**Year 11 Leadership – Mrs A Done:** The Leadership group will be going for a three day (two nights away) Expedition to an Outdoor Education Centre, in Conway. Pupils will stay in 4\* Hostel accommodation and take part in a range of activities including: obstacle course, team initiative challenges, bush craft, orienteering, gorge walking, climbing and abseiling The expedition will depart from school on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October and return on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October, in time for buses (5.30pm).
