Dear Parent,

As your son/daughter joins Ellesmere College they will have the option of being a part of Arts Award on Thursday afternoons. We spend time developing individual and team skills, focusing on creativity and leadership, and students have the opportunity to work towards their Arts Award, accredited by the Arts Council. Students learn how to develop existing skills or take on new challenges and the focus is on the journey. They are encouraged to reflect on their experiences and support one another on larger-scale projects.

For the October Expo, I have organised a three-day immersive arts experience in London – please see details below. The purpose is to experience professional theatre, explore galleries and gain a better understanding of how many different teams feed into profession productions.
