Dear Parent,

It was lovely to see many families at the Chapel Service on Sunday to commemorate Remembrance and thank you also to parents and children for supporting the Royal British Legion with the purchase of poppies. There was an Old Ellesmerian luncheon afterwards and it was good to see many OE Lower School pupils return and visit the College.

This week we have hosted visitors from a school in China. The visitors were impressed with the enthusiasm and work ethic of pupils when they saw them working in class. It is always nice to pass on compliments to the children.

The recent 'Castles Competition' was a successful event. Mrs Paton was really impressed with the standard of entry this year. Some of the castles are particularly large and therefore the children may require a little help transporting them home before the end of term.

Following the Year 8 social bowling night, the Year 8 girls recently enjoyed an 'Evening of Elegance'. It was a simple and fun event exploring skin care and hair styles appropriate for young teenage girls. Next term there will be a social activity planned specifically for the Year 8 boys.

We are entering into the busy phase of music rehearsals and play practices in readiness for the Michaelmas Term festivities. Pupils are looking forward to The House Play Festival on the 30<sup>th</sup> November. Last year the plays created, directed and performed by the pupils were excellent and a testimony to the talent that we have on stage and backstage in Lower School.
