EXPEDITIONS - Michaelmas 2017

I am writing to inform you of this term's 3 day expedition destinations for Wednesday 18th October to Friday 20th October 2017. Your son/daughter will be informed in much greater detail of their individual expedition, but this letter is to appraise you of the timings and general overview of those staff in charge.

Arts Award – Blackpool Group - Mrs R. Paul: Will depart for Blackpool, returning in time for buses on the Friday. Students will be looking at the Circus and theatre productions amongst other events.

Green Team - Mrs C. Allen: Will be going to Hemsley in North Yorkshire.
