EXPEDITIONS – Summer 2018

I am writing to inform you of this term's four day expedition destinations for Monday 25th June to Thursday 28th June 2018. Your son/daughter will be informed in detail of their individual expedition, but this letter is to appraise you of the timings and general overview of those staff in charge.

Gold DofE walking will depart on Saturday 23rd June 4pm and return on the evening of Wednesday 27th June, using the Thursday as a consolidation of your child's paperwork.

Gold DofE Canoeists will depart on Sunday 24th June 3pm returning on Thursday.

The Naval and RAF section will depart on Sunday 24th June at 10am for Portsmouth, returning on Thursday.
